Within the DSDM Agile Programme Framework you will find capabilities to handle a wide range of project approaches, not exclusively Agile. The Framework itself is very Agile, incorporating iterative and incremental delivery of benefits, just-in-time planning and frequent review.

In addition, its governance model ensures the programme will capture its vision, whilst empowering teams to work without undue interference. Built on firm foundations, the programme can evolve and react to business change in our increasingly dynamic world.

Both seasoned programme managers, and those new to the area, will find this guidance offers valuable and practical advice for running successful programmes with an Agile focus.
