















Artifacts allow additional information to be provided on a process model

> Data Objects are inputs to and outputs from activities. Data objects could be used to represent documents, data or other objects that are passed between the activities in a





A **Message** is used to depict the contents of a communication between 2 participants.



A **Group** is a visual way of informally grouping items on a diagram, for example to highlight an area that requires further analysis.



**Annotations** allow additional information relevant in documenting the process to be shown on the diagram.

## Gateways

Gateways represent decisions within the process, and control the splitting and merging of sequence



A diverging **Exclusive Gateway** is used to create alternative paths within a Process flow. A converging Exclusive Gateway is used to merge alternative



A Parallel Gateway is used to synchronize parallel flows and to create
